# The Teacher Pipeline

*The Teacher Pipeline is unique to Coweta County, Georgia Schools (CCSS). The Teacher Pipeline of CCSS is a project that*

- is research-based and data-driven;
- attracts the best and brightest of our middle and high school students;
- motivates them to consider education careers through Future Educators Association (FEA) in middle and/or high school;
- encourages them to take high school education courses in order to thoroughly explore teaching as a profession;
- informs students about state college and university programs in education;
- assists students in making post-secondary decisions; and
- recruits Pipeline students back to our community to become the next certified teachers for CCSS.

The Teacher Pipeline has an association with Phi Delta Kappa (PDK), the parent organization for Future Educators of America (FEA). PDK plans to partner with CCSS to conduct research dealing with FEA's in middle schools, the University of West Georgia (UWG) 4th Year Intern Pilot Project, and other longitudinal data that would benefit both the school system and the university.
